

Nathan Miller/Michelle Treseler vs. Elections Commission
Judicial Review Board Case 312-001

The Review Board in a 5-1 decision, with one recusal, determined that Nathan Miller and Michelle Treseler cannot be on the ballot as candidates in the 2005 Student Assembly Election. Pursuant to §5.4-6, the plaintiffs had received verbal and written notice that they had to turn in both signed and online forms in order to be a candidate. Nathan Miller and Michelle Treseler submitted the online, but not the signed, form. The signed document granted the Elections Commission permission to ensure a potential candidate's eligibility for the intended office. The Review Board determined that the online form was not sufficient to declare intent of candidacy. Since the plaintiffs did not turn in both forms by the deadline established by the Elections Commission, they are not eligible to be on the ballot.
