A Bill

to Amend the Constitution of the Student Assembly of the College of William & Mary in Virginia to Create Sounder Elections within the Student Assembly.

**Later Elections Afforded to Freshmen (LEAF Amendment).**

A bill of the Student Assembly Senate of the College of William and Mary in Virginia. Introduced for the Senate's consideration by Senator Brett Philips ('08), Senator Drew Cockram ('08) & Senator Victor Sulkowski ('07).

WHEREAS, members of the freshman class leadership and general body have expressed that fall elections are held too early to enable a broad and detailed understanding of the Student Assembly for the College's newest members;

WHEREAS, an informed pool of candidates and elected officials is in the best interest of the freshman class and the entire student body; and

WHEREAS, the student body will have a greater opportunity to know the candidates, allowing them to place a more informed vote: Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Senate of the Student Assembly of the College of William and Mary in Virginia –

- (1) amends the Constitution by changing Article V, Section II, Subsection II to read:

"Freshman Elections shall be held on the third Thursday in September unless the Senate makes special exception by a vote of three of every four Senators then holding office."
