**The 2009 Closing of Session Act**

An Act of the 317<sup>th</sup> Student Assembly of the College of William and Mary,  
Sponsored by Senator Ben Brown of the Class of 2011

WHEREAS, a new group of Student Assembly officials have been duly elected and sworn into office;

WHEREAS, there were many bills pending at the close of the 316<sup>th</sup> Session of the Senate; and

WHEREAS, this bill was first introduced by Senator James Evans from the Class of 2007;

Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Senate of the Student Assembly of the College of William and Mary –

1. Classifies every pending bill from 316<sup>th</sup> Student Assembly Senates as dead and unable to be acted upon by the Senate, and
2. Reclassifies the following bills as bills of the 317<sup>th</sup> Student Assembly Senate:
