A Bill

To Provide the Collegiate Readership Program at W&M

**The Collegiate Readership Act**

An Act of the 317<sup>th</sup> Student Assembly of the College of William and Mary,

Sponsored by Senator Caroline Mullis from the Class of 2009 and Senator Benjamin Brown from the Class of 2011

WHEREAS, the Collegiate Readership Program has been widely supported on campus, garnering approximately 64% of the vote in a referendum during SA elections

WHEREAS, the bill approving the addition of a \$6 was passed too late for it to be added to the 2009-2010 budget,

Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Student Assembly of the College of William and Mary –

1. Institutes the Collegiate Readership Program here at W&M starting this coming fall, and
2. Earmarks up to \$37,000 from the Consolidated Reserves to The Collegiate Readership program, and
3. Charges the sponsors of this bill to ensure that a fee is added to the 2010-2011 budget to support the continuity of the program, and
4. Shows the Senate's continued support of the addition of a \$6 fee for this use as opposed to money from the Consolidated Reserves.
