A Bill

To Provide Transportation Service to Summer Session and International Students

**The Summer Shuttle Service Act**

An Act of the 317<sup>th</sup> Student Assembly of the College of William and Mary,

Sponsored by Senators Karl Mendoza (MS '10) and Ben Brown ('11)

WHEREAS, William & Mary transportation will cease operation during the summer;

WHEREAS, approximately 550 summer session, international, and research students will remain on campus;

WHEREAS, many of said students will need a convenient connection among the Sadler Center, Gradplex, Williamsburg Transportation hub (Amtrak station), and Bloom (Richmond Rd.) to procure groceries, medicines, and other necessities; and

WHEREAS, said students require a reasonably safe, reliable, and environmentally-friendly option;

Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Student Assembly of the College of William and Mary-

1. Provide \$2000 from the Consolidated Reserve to fund a taxi shuttle program between any two of the locations mentioned above, during days which the Green/Gold bus lines cease operation, including the entirety of both summer sessions;
2. Charges the Student Assembly Executive with ensuring an online system to schedule rides, maintain a record, and reliably monitor ridership rates is put in place.
