To Fund a Taxi Service So Students do not Walk Alone Late During Finals

**The Exam Taxi Service Act II**

An Act

of the 317<sup>th</sup> Student Assembly of the College of William and Mary,

Sponsored by Senator Walter McClean from the Class of 2009 and Brittany Fallon from the Class of 2011

WHEREAS, final exams are a time when many students are up late studying in various places around campus;

WHEREAS, many students would feel safer going on and off campus if they did not have to walk at night;

WHEREAS, there is no public transportation from 12am-7am Sunday-Thursday evenings;

WHEREAS, exam nights are May 2<sup>nd</sup> to May 13<sup>th</sup>; and

WHEREAS, the College Administration has successfully run taxi services for students in the past:

Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Student Assembly of the College of William and Mary –

- (1) Allocates up to \$1300 from the Student Consolidated Reserve to the College of William and Mary Department of Parking and Transportation for the purpose of paying, on a per ride basis, for a taxi service within a five mile radius of campus;
- (2) Requires that this service run from May 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2008 to May 13<sup>th</sup>, 2008 between the hours of midnight and 7am;
- (3) Charges the sponsor of this bill and the Executive with publicizing this service to students and coordinating its implementation with the Administration's Department of Parking and Transportation.
